You will make your way to Snake Basin, located at the base of Mount Daly and Clark's Peak. Unknown to even locals, this ride provides something you have never seen before. In a short time we break out of the trees in Snake Basin. Here, guests will be welcomed into one of our rustic base camps at the foot of Mt. Daly and Clark's Peak. This beautiful high altitude basin is the perfect place to have lunch, relax, and take photos of this spectacular area. The way down is just spectacular and enjoyable as the way up. - * On the horse back ride we will stop so the teacher can explain how the working ranch operates. Livestock is still a vital need for the horses.
- * After the ride you will be shown how to put back all the tack appropriately, the way one should be stored
- * Before you let your horse go you can feed it some treat and get some photos with it.
